1	Scope of work : 5,000 m core drilling in Pavati-Selpur area, Udaipur District, Rajasthan with borehole depth varying from 150 to 300 metre.
2	Type of Drilling: Core Drilling.
3	Size of the boreholes: Combination of H/N/B size (96.00mm/75.70mm/ 60.00 mm bore hole diameter approximately).
4	Depth of the boreholes: In the range of 150 to 300 metre. The above depth range is approximate only. Depending on the requirement and site conditions, marginal variation may occur.
5	Inclination of the borehole: 50 ⁰ to 70 ⁰ inclined.
6	Deviation limits for borehole Angle: a) Deviation in borehole Angle of maximum 2 ⁰ for each 100 metre depth will be allowed in each borehole. Therefore, the contractors are advised to take all precautions to drill the boreholes within these limits. b) Periodical deviation test will be arranged by the Resident Geologist.
7	Rock Formations to be drilled: Hornblende schist and pegmatite (rarely felsite).
8	Number of Rigs to be deployed : 2 Surface Core drilling rig of capacity to drill 150 metre or more in 'N' size. Srirangapatna is the nearest major town at a distance of 6 km from the site. It has road and rail connectivity from Bengaluru with approximately 135 km distance. 5 **Combined eligibility for similar works:** As both the works under this NIT are of similar nature i.e. core drilling, if a party quotes for more than one work of similar nature, the second bid of the same party will be considered only, if they fulfill the combined eligibility criteria in respect of availability of rigs, solvency, annual turnover, work experience etc., for both the works quoted. In such case the combined bid capacity will be evaluated and considered as follows taking into account the total credentials required for all the works during techno-commercial evaluation.

- I. Price Bids will be opened as per the serial number indicated in the scope of work of NIT.
- II. Price bids of the work under serial no. 1 will be opened first and L-1 will be selected. In case the selected L-1 bidder of the first work is also a bidder in the second or consecutive works, his price bid will be opened only if he qualifies the combined eligibility criteria for all the works quoted.

In case L-1 bidder of the first work does not fulfill the combined eligibility criteria for the second or consecutive works, his price bid for the second work or consecutive works will not be opened.

Note: Before submitting bids for more than one work, bidders should ensure that they fulfill the combined bidding criteria as per the above table and submit documentary evidences.

6 **Submission of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**

- (a) EMD should be deposited in the form of crossed Demand Draft, drawn on any nationalized/scheduled bank in favor of The Pay & Accounts Officer, AMD/DAE payable at SECUNDERABAD.
- (b) Cheque, Bank Guarantees and Postal Orders will not be accepted towards EMD.
- (c) EMD should be enclosed in a separate envelop along with Part – I (Technical bid).
- (d) The tenders without Earnest Money Deposit in the prescribed manner are liable to be rejected.
- (e) The successful Tenderer, hereafter referred to as the Contractor, shall deposit an amount equal to 5% (five percent) of the bid amount as performance guarantee within the period specified in the Letter of Intent. The Earnest Money deposited with the bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee and confirmation from bank.

7	General Instructions for Submission of Tender: Bids should be submitted in sealed covers in the following manner.
(a)	The tenders shall be in two parts viz. Part-I (i.e. Technical bid) and Part-II (i.e. Commercial bid). Part-I shall contain the documents in support of Cost of Tender Document (in case of downloaded tenders), EMD, the details of technical qualifications, competence of the tenderer supported by certificates as required vide eligibility criteria for issue of tender documents specified in the NIT.
(b)	The Part – II shall be the commercial bid containing the schedule of quantities issued along with tender documents, duly filled in by the tenderer along with commercial terms if any.
