GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSIONS IN CLASS-1 UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF RTE ACT

(Only for applicants seeking admission under the provisions of RTE Act in Class-I for the Academic Session 2022-23)

This circular contains the guidelines for admission into Class-1 under RTE Act in AECS-1 & 2, Hyderabad for the Academic Session, 2022-23.

Mere issue and acceptance of admission form will not guarantee the admission to the students under RTE Act.

Children who were born on or after 01/04/2015 and on or before 01/04/2017 residing in the neighbourhood area, who belong to Disadvantaged Group and/or Weaker Section are eligible to seek admission under the provisions of RTE Act, 2009.

1. Definition:

DEFINITION OF DISADVANTAGED GROUP

- (i) Child belonging to disadvantaged group means a child belonging to the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, the socially and educationally backward class or such other group having disadvantage owing to social, cultural, economic, geographical, linguistic, gender or such other factor as may be specified by the appropriate government, by notification (Section 2(d) of RTE Act).
- (ii) Child with special needs and suffering from disability will be determined as per the provision mentioned in RTE Act 2009 or as defined by the concerned State Govt.

DEFINITION OF WEAKER SECTION

Child belonging to weaker section means a child belonging to such a parent or guardian (declared by a Court or a Statute) whose annual income is lower than the minimum limit specified by the appropriate government, by notification (Section 2(e) of RTE Act). The income limit regarding economically weaker sections will be applicable as notified by the State Govt. concerned.

DEFINITION OF NEIGHBOURHOOD & PROOF OF RESIDENCE

Since AEC Schools are located in different states the respective State Govt. guidelines regarding the definition of neighbourhood may be followed. A self-declaration in writing from the parent about distance of the residence from the school in which admission is sought may be accepted to this effect. (for details see point Nos. 5.5 & 5.6).

2. Application Forms

Application Form for admission can be downloaded from the websites of AECS-1 & 2, Hyderabad: www.aecshyd1.edu.in / www.aecshyd2.edu.in. The duly filled in form should be submitted at AECS-1, Hyderabad.

OR

Application Form for admission can also be obtained from the office of AECS-1, Hyderabad. The duly filled in form should be submitted at AECS-1, Hyderabad as per the given below schedule.

3. Admission schedule:

Note:

- (i) 11/04/2022, 14/04/2022, 15/04/2022, 16/04/2022 & 17/04/2022 are holidays for school.
- (ii) No change in schedule is allowed without prior approval of the Central office, AEES.
- (iii) Distribution of Application / Admission Forms and its submission, display of lists, final admission etc. shall be done at AECS-1, Hyderabad.

4. Fee to be paid:

No fee will be charged from students admitted under RTE Act in class I till they complete Class-VIII. However, the employees who have the facility of fee reimbursement by the employer cannot claim RTE concessions.

5. Documents to be submitted alongwith the application form by applicants seeking admission under the provisions of RTEact.


- 5.1. Wherever admission is sought under the provisions of RTE Act, the self-attested copies of the following documents are required to be submitted along with the application form. The originals of these documents shall be produced at the time of admission for verification.
- 5.2. Certificate of proof of age in the form of birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council/ Municipality/ Municipality Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat endorsed under the seal and signature of the Revenue/Panchayat officer of the concerned

area.

- 5.3. A certificate that the child belongs to the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/EWS/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/ BPL/ Differently-abled, wherever applicable, issued by the competent Authority of State Government / Union Government concerned. The certificate in respect of Either of the parents may be accepted initially, for the purpose of admission, if this certificate is not available for the child. However, the certificate in respect of the child has to be submitted within a period of 3 Months from the date of admission.
- 5.4. A Certificate from the civil surgeon / rehabilitation centre or any other competent authority defined by the Government of India certifying the child to be handicapped, wherever applicable. In case, where the handicap of the child can be visually seen by the principal the child may be accepted as handicapped even without a certificate. However, the parent may be advised to obtain the relevant certificate from the competent authority and submit the same to the school.
- 5.5. Residential address proof in the name of the parent of applicant and the distance from the school should be within the radius of 5 KMS. The Rental Agreement on stamp paper will not be considered.
- 5.6. The following documents for residential address proof will be accepted.
- i) Ration card
 - ii) Gas bill
 - iii) Pattadar Passbook
 - iv) Electricity bill
 - v) Aadhar card
 - vi) House tax receipt or extract of the house tax register maintained by the Gram Panchayat / Municipality / Corporation
 - vii) Telephone bill
- 5.7. Latest Income Certificate / BPL Certificate with a validity period of parents issued by the employer concerned or Revenue Department of their residing locality.
- 5.8.. Aadhar Card of the parents
- 5.9. Aadhar card of the child (if available)

1. Certificate of proof of age in the form of birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council/ Municipality/ Municipality Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat endorsed under the seal and signature of the Revenue/Panchayat officer of the concerned area.
2. A certificate that the child belongs to the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/ EWS/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/ BPL/ CWSN, wherever applicable, issued by the competent authority in concerned State Government/ Union Government. The certificate as applicable in respect of either of the parents may be accepted initially, for the purpose of admission, if this certificate is not available for the child. However, the certificate in respect of the child has to be submitted within a period of 03 Months from the date of admission.
3. A Certificate from the civil surgeon/rehabilitation centre or any other competent authority defined by the Government of India certifying the child to be handicapped, wherever applicable. In case, where the handicap of the child can be visually seen by the principal, the child may be accepted as handicapped even without a certificate. However, the parent may be advised to obtain the relevant certificate from the competent authority and submit the same to the school.
